### **57.11(7) Personnel**

- Failure to ensure medication orders were correctly implemented for multiple residents. Medications were given but not documented. (R 373)
- Resident was hospitalized for diarrhea and dehydration and Immodium was signed by the physician to be given on prn. Medication was never added to MAR for resident. (R 373)

#### 57.12 General Policies

• Failure to ensure there was a policy regarding health and safety that included comprehensive information regarding non-emergency situations. A resident had a change in condition that was noticed by staff, but no vitals taken or contact to the on-call staff and the resident was found deceased the next morning. (R 398)

### 57.13(1)a Admission, Transfer, Discharge

• Level of cares were not ordered for multiple residents prior to admission. (R 456)

#### 57.17 Records

- (1)o Failure to complete a notation of condition upon discharge for several residents. (R
  616)
- **(3)b** Incident report forms were missing detail. Only contained vital signs and the time the resident and family were notified. **(R 636)**

#### 57.22(3) Orientation and Service Plan

• Failure to ensure service plan completed within 30-days of admission for multiple residents. (R 828)

- b Failure to ensure changes in a resident's meal plan were documented. (R 832)
- d Failure to ensure quarterly service plans were complete for a resident. (R 836)

## 57.36(2) Maintenance

• Failure to maintain the building in good repair. Ceiling was damaged, cracked tiles in the floor, drywall marred and scraped. (R 1058)
